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The only criteria a trafficker uses in choosing a victim is

VULNERABILITY,

and your clients are some of the most vulnerable in your community.

That single mom struggling to make ends meet, or that anxious young man that you're working with, could be under the control of a trafficker.

Providing her with utility bill assistance and him with relaxation exercises is great, but there may be more that you can do to help.

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Those who help need help in identifying and providing appropriate resources for clients who are sex trafficking victims, and those who are at risk of becoming victims.

Unmasked gives you the simple insights needed to look behind the basic needs and recognize someone in danger.
