Sex Trafficking Training for Salon Professionals



Who's in My Chair training is appropriate for anyone who works in a salon environment, including hairstylists, nail techs, aestheticians, makeup artists, support staff and more.



Professionals who work in salons have a unique opportunity to interact with trafficking victims for two reasons:
#1 - The victim's appearance is the trafficker's packaging, and he wants it to look appealing.

#2 - For some reason, when we sit down in a salon chair, we relax and open up. We'll sometimes tell the person working on our hair, face and nails things we don't even tell our families!

Salon professionals who know what to look for and what steps to take if they have suspicions can be a key in the fight against sex trafficking.
